The UN Women country office, in collaboration with UNICEF and with spotlight funds, supported the government through the Ministry of Justice to conduct a comparative study and analysis of the national legislative framework related to violence, women's and girls' sexual and reproductive health rights (SRHR) and harmful practices (NP) in Niger. This study has mobilized and federated national stakeholders from key sectoral ministries to the deconcentrated level, the UNS, CSOs and several other TFPs and has allowed us to formulate relevant recommendations aiming at the implementation of new reforms on the fight against GBV, including the elaboration of a specific law on GBV and the revision of the penal code and the code of criminal procedures in Niger. The review of the latter is already underway.
