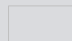

A total of 1 360 women mediatrices including 160 One hundred and sixty in 2022 have trained and made operational and intervene on issues of conflict prevention and management, mediation, sensitization, promotion and protection of women's and girls' rights, leadership of women and girls, elimination of gender-based violence, consideration of women's and girls' needs in the consolidation process in Tillabery. And In 2022, a total of 14837 Women's and girls were engaged by UN Women in peacebuilding and prevention, IGA, combating harmful practices.
