The programme interventions engage the government and civil society partners to create an enabling environment for implementation, monitoring and reporting of the NAP 1325--by focusing on advocating for adequate financial accountability frameworks for the NAP 1325; and ensuring that civil society has the capacity and resources to monitor the NAP 1325 and to carry out evidence-based advocacy for implementation of the women, peace and security agenda in Afghanistan.
