Haitian women, with a special focus on victims of violence, have increased access to justice services

Though the Spotlight Programme, in 2022, progress has been made in creating the conditions for strengthening the legal and statutory environment in favor of the elimination of violence against women and girls. The country now has the preliminary report of an analysis of the legislative and legal framework on women's rights in the light of international standards and principles. In addition knowledge resources and tools have been created, piloted and capacity building sessions conducted to strengthen institutional capacities on gender-sensitive programming and budgeting (GRB) and Violence Against Women and Girls [VAWG]. Continued collaboration with civil society organizations has made it possible to further increase people's access to information and education on the prevention of violence against women and girls, including domestic violence, in the program intervention areas.
