Technical and financial support to the Cairo International Center for Conflict Resolution, Peacekeeping and Peacebuilding (CCCCPA) and NCW to develop Egypt's first high-impact National Action Plan (NAP) for the implementation of UNSCR 1325 on Women, Peace and Security (WPS). A costing and validation workshop of the NAP is also planned under this results. The GoE will launch the 'Aswan Forum for Sustainable Peace and Development' under the patronage of H.E. President Abdel Fattah Al Sisi. The forum is a platform where the WPS agenda can be advanced across the African continent whilst linking it to the broader stabilization system and dialogue. It will present concrete and action-oriented recommendations to African heads of states and governments, leaders from national governments, regional and international organizations and financial institutions, the private sector, and civil society. Lastly, implementation of community awareness campaigns around the NAP.
