
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Outcome Description



UN Women raised the WPS Agenda in BARMM by ensuring that needs of women and girls in conflict-impacted areas area reflected in local Gender and Development plans in over 17 local government units, ensuring that programs and services reach the most vulnerable women and girls in the Bangsamoro region.
