






WHAT CAN BE FOUND ON THE PAGES PER IMPACT AREA, SYSTEMIC OUTCOME AND ORGANIZATIONAL OUTPUT?

On the map, users can view the countries contributing to results including expenses and funding partners for a respective impact area, systemic outcome or organizational output.

Further, the pages show result highlights, financial flows (only for impact areas and systemic outcomes) and data against the indicators of the UN-Women Strategic Plan Integrated Results and Resources Framework (SP IRRF).












Regular resource contributions over time




See regular resources contributions over time, or compare contributions of up to five funding partners

Regular resources contributing to country programmes






Top 25 regular resource partners in 2024

Disability inclusion

In 2024, UN-Women with United Nations entities, Organisations of Persons with Disabilities, and organizations and networks of women with disabilities addressed stigma, discrimination and violence against women and girls with disabilities. UN-Women and UNDP, in collaboration with the Global Disability Fund, created a new measure, The Women with Disabilities Stigma Inventory, along with accompanying resources, to assess the experiences of women and girls with disabilities. A policy brief outlined actionable and evidence-based recommendations that were piloted in **Moldova, Pakistan, Samoa** and the
